**Free *Where Does Your Money Go?* Programs
Offered by the United Way of Marshall County**

Plymouth, Indiana – The United Way of Marshall County will host free *Where Does Your Money Go?* programs over the next few months in Plymouth, Culver, Argos and Bremen. The program is designed to help individuals who experience difficulty paying bills on time, running out of money before the end of the month, or saving for the future. Program participants will receive an introductory course in money management and financial stability which consists of four 1½ hour classes created by Purdue Extension. *Where Does Your Money Go?* students will learn to:

- 1) Think differently about managing their money,
- 2) Recognize where their money goes,
- 3) Stop spending leaks to save money for what they really want, and
- 4) Develop a spending-savings plan.
