Link to Hope is available to assist Marshall County residents from the loss of income directly-related to COVID-19 -- loss of job, reduced hours, COVID-19 illnesses, etc. Link to Hope will work closely with the Township Trustees and other agencies to coordinate assistance for housing and utilities.

STEP ONE: Apply for rent assistance by 11:59 pm Wednesday, August 26, 2020 at:

STEP TWO: Call the **Marshall County Housing and Utility Hotline -- 574-380-0500**. An appointment will be made to complete necessary paperwork to take to the next step. Get a head start!

STEP THREE: Attend the pre-arranged appointment which will be held in the Marshall County Community Resource Center, 510 W. Adams St., Plymouth, Indiana.

Requirements:

A mask must be worn by all persons.
Limited to one person in the interview.
No children are allowed at the appointment unless pre-arranged.
Bring all necessary documentation which includes:
Photo ID/Driver's License
Copies of the bill(s)
Copy of lease/mortgage documentation
Landlord's address and phone number
