OUR IMPACT

How we are advancing the common good, together.

Together, we take a hard, long look at the problems facing our communities, bringing people from all walks of life into the solution conversation.

United Way is a driving force because change doesn't happen along. Together, here is the impact we are making:

- **\$750,000** Indiana Family/Social Services Administration grant launches Marshall County TriShare Pilot Program to share the cost of childcare equally among the employer, employee, and local investment.
- **\$438,100** Early Years Initiative grant expands infant and toddler care through local providers across Marshall County.
- **\$350,500** for Marshall County HOPE and substance use disorder prevention, treatment, and recovery services.
- **\$316,000** capital grant in partnership with Indiana United Ways for Dustin's Place to expand to serve more families facing grief.
- **1,900** Marshall County children ages 0-5 to be enrolled by 2030 in Marshall County's Imagination Library.

YOUR DOLLARS MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Together, we can make a difference:

- **\$26** can provide children ages 0-5 a free book each month for a year through the Marshall County Imagination Library.
- **\$300** can provide 1 month of utility assistance for a family to keep their home warm and their lights on.
- **\$500** can provide childcare for 2 weeks for a family with 2 young children.
- **\$1,000** can provide groceries for 1 month for a family of 4.
